London 10K Run 6th July 2008

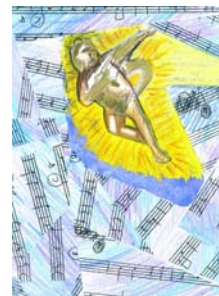
This is a new event for us, but one that has been going for three years already, so is a well established and well organised run.
